YCW Chateau de Farcheville

YCW Château de Farcheville, originally consecrated between 1290 to 1304, features modern amenities and facilities, ensuring that YCW Members enjoy complete comfort and convenience as they've come to expect at any luxury residence or resort, without compromising the integrity of the chateau's architecture and history. Upon the recent completion of an extensive 14-year renovation project entrusted to renowned restoration companies and artists, under the direction of a dedicated and talented Historical Monument architect, Château de Farcheville ranks today among the most magnificent private properties in France.

The Château's layout, with its central enclosed and protected cobblestone courtyard, provides a grand yet warm sense of welcome. The chateau's interior decor reflects a harmonious blend of styles -- from the rigorous decorum of the 14th Century to the rich and opulent decor of the Second Empire. The Château features a variety of dining rooms; salons; a great hall; a private theatre fully equipped for concerts, small stage performances and movie screenings; a world-class wine cellar; a chapel; underground dungeons; a library; herb, vegetable and flower gardens; and numerous outdoor terraces overlooking the Chateau's surrounding moat. On the far side of the moat lies a separate, charming 19th Century Orangerie (greenhouse) devoted to sports and relaxation. The chateau's Orangerie features a heated indoor pool, a fully-equipped spa and gym, an oriental tea-room, an authentic *Hammam* (Turkish bath), massage rooms, an exotic garden and meditation room flanked by orangeries, arbors and pergolas.

Accommodations at Chateau de Farcheville include 12 en-suite accommodations, a *Chambre du Roy* – special suite originally reserved for the exclusive use of the King, should His Majesty ever visit the castle and an extraordinary and fully-equipped Master's Apartment. The Château also features four main kitchens – a 14th Century kitchen, a 16th Century family kitchen, an 18th Century wood- and-copper pastry kitchen and a fully-refurbished, professional kitchen. These numerous kitchens reflect the chateau's periodic adaptation to changing times throughout the centuries, affording YCW Château de Farcheville guests a unique experience.

The grounds of YCW Chateau de Farcheville encompass an expansive 1,125 acres, including a 395-acre forest, and features a 16th Century watchtower, a small 'Temple of Love', a tennis court, a private helipad and numerous hiking and biking trails. The chateau is surrounded by a completely reconditioned moat, and set in the centre of a walled and landscaped park of 25 acres (including a beautiful 3-acre 18th Century flower garden). Equipped with modern security systems, YCW Château de Farcheville guarantees Members and guests the utmost in privacy.

Damien Rizzi has been appointed General Manager of Yellowstone Club World Chateau de Farcheville, overseeing the day-to-day operations of this unique destination including management of its staff, the Chateau's extensive grounds, facilities and amenities. Damien is a graduate from the renowned *Ecole Hoteliere Lausanne* in Switzerland where he received his Masters in Hospitality Administration. Prior to his position at YCW Chateau de Farcheville, Damien, who is fully fluent English, French, Italian and Spanish, was the Assistant Manager at Hotel el Faro, a luxury condominium-hotel development in Playa del Carmen, Mexico.

YCW Château de Farcheville today stands as a rare example of a rural, 'open-field' French castle dating from the medieval period. Original ownership of the immense land under the territories of Bouville and

Farcheville can be traced to Queen Marguerite de Provence (1291 – 1295). In 1290, Hughes II, a knight and the First Chamberlain to Philippe Le Bel (King of France from 1285 to 1314), became sole owner of the Farcheville lands. Hughes II de Bouville et de Farcheville, due to his prominent advisory capacity to the then reigning French monarch and head of the entire dynasty of Chamberlains, was an extremely powerful man; and commissioned the construction of Chateau de Farcheville to display his eminence in French society. In 1987 the owner of Chateau de Farcheville undertook an extensive renovation of the chateau with the assistance of Pierre-André Lablaude, Head Architect of Historical Monuments -- a guardianship in France known as *Monument historique* where the State institutes a decree for a building or a specific part of a building, a collection of buildings or an entire neighborhood, plus gardens, bridges, and other structures because of their architectural and historical importance. YCW Chateau de Farcheville is the only medieval castle in the *Isle de France* region to have survived both the Wars of the religions in the 15th and 16th Century and the French Revolutions of the 18th and 19th Centuries.

YCW Chateau de Farcheville is located in Bouville, in the arrondissement of Étampes, in the Île-de-France region. Nearby attractions in the region include Chateau de Fontainebleau – a UNESCO world heritage site featuring this world famous chateau and majestic gardens (25 miles/40km), *Palais de Versailles*, the renowned and ornate Summer palace for French monarchs (38 miles/61 km), the nearby charming and picturesque village of *Milly La Foret*, a picturesque little French village (10 miles/17km), the quaint, historically artistic village of *Barbizon* – credited as the cradle of the pre-impressionist painters of the 19th century (25 miles/40km). Paris' Champs Elysees (City Center) is a short drive away (45miles/70 km). In addition, immediate recreational activities available for YCW Members staying at Chateau de Farcheville include golf, equestrian and air-ballooning off the grounds of YCW Chateau de Farcheville.
